

REGULATIONS FOR THE IMPORTATION OF MEAT AND BONE MEAL (MBM)
INTO THE STATE OF SARAWAK, MALAYSIA

(Effective from 10th January 2013)

A. Products : Meat and Bone Meal (MBM) of ruminant origin

B. Country of exoprt: Australia And New Zealand

C. Purpose : Animal Feeding

D. Regulations for importation:-

1. Veterinary Certificate

Each consignment of the MBM shall be accompanied by a **Veterinary Health Certificate** dated within 14 days of export and signed and endorsed by the competent Veterinary Authority of the country of origin giving details of the consignment (such as name and address of consignor and consignee, quantity, type and origin of products) and certifying that:

- 1.1. The country of origin has been free from foot and mouth disease, rinderpest, peste des petits ruminants and antrax during the preceding 12 months prior to export
- 1.2. bovine spongiform encephalopathy has never been reported in the country
- 1.3. The animals from which the MBM was derived were locally born and bred and were certified healthy at the time of slaughter
- 1.4. Only products of ruminant origin have been used in the production of MBM
- 1.5. The MBM was manufactured in plants which are approved and registered by the veterinary authority of the country of export, and are capable of achieving the processing parameters listed in 1.6 below
- 1.6. The MBM has been prepared in the following manner:
 - 1.6.1 the raw material should be reduced to a maximum particle size of 50mm before heating
 - 1.6.2 the raw material should be heated under saturated steam conditions to a temperature of not less than 133C for a minimum of 20 minutes at an absolute pressure of 3 bar
- 1.7. After treatment and processing necessary precautions have been taken to prevent contamination with potential source of pathogens or infectious agents
- 1.8. The products were packed and sealed directly into sterlized packaging or bags at the manufacturing plant

2. Labelling Requirement

2.1. The packaging or bag must be clearly marked with the words;

"MBM DERIVED FROM PRODUCTS OF RUMINANT ORIGIN" and "STRICTLY NOT FOR USE IN RUMINANTS"

2.2. The list of raw materials or ingredients and the nutritional data should be clearly recorded on the packaging or

3. Import Licence

Each consignment of MBM shall be accompanied by a valid **import licence** issued by the State Veterinary Authority permitting the importation of such products into the State of Sarawak, Malaysia.

Import Licence = RM10 per consignment
