



How Does the Program Work?

JETRO Will submit your company's information to nearly 200 Japanese companies who are seeking new technology in North America. The Japanese companies will notify JETRO of their interest, after which time your nearest JETRO office will contact you with the Japanese companies' responses and contact information where appropriate.





Japanese Venture Firm Support




