

Steps for your incorporation and business expansion in Japan



One to three months (Varies depending on business profile)



Temporary Offices

A free temporary office is available up to 50 business days during the preparation period to establish your business base in Japan.

Requirements JETRO's certified foreign/foreign-affiliated companies planning to invest or expand their business in

Japan *To receive the certification, please contact your nearest JETRO office and apply with the required documents. JETRO H.O. will examine whether it meets the conditions required for support.

Tenancy period Up to 50 business days in principle (may be extended for another 50 business days, making up to 100

business days in total available.)

Private office area 13.5m² (for 2 people)/18.0m² (for 3 people)/36.0m² (for 6 people) *Approximate size Tenancy fee Free of charge for 50 business days (It will be charged for the 51st day and after.)

Facilities Private office: desks, chairs, file cabinets and internet connection

Common area: printer, shredder

JETRO Innovation Garden (Located on the 7th floor of JETRO H.O.): meeting rooms, open-area

(co-working space with 50 seats) and event area (capacity for 70 people)

Tokyo One-Stop Business Establishment Center

(located next to JETRO IBSC Tokyo)

This is a support center jointly operated by the Japanese government and the Tokyo metropolitan government. Free, one-stop services are provided to help complete procedures necessary to establish a company and to start business in Tokyo.



- Support with completing procedures necessary to establish a company and to start business (Certification of articles of incorporation, company registration, taxes, pension/social security, immigration, etc.)

- Multilingual interpretation and translation services
