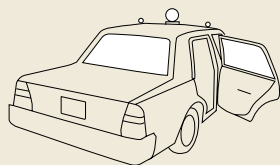

- DON'T tip – it can be insulting

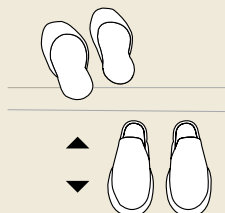
● OMIYAGE

● PRIVATE VISITS

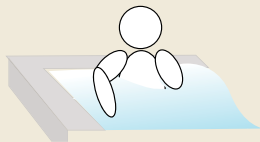
- DO remove shoes when entering a home and leave shoes pointing towards the door
